

# No temporary solutions for agri problems: VP

**On his visit to MU yesterday, Vice-President Naidu talked about co-operatives and how agricultural problems need a permanent solution**

**G** racing the University of Mumbai yesterday for the Laxmanrao Inamdar's Memorial lecture, Vice President Venkaiah Naidu

talked about co-operatives, urbanisation, farmers and culture. Also present at the event were Governor Vidyasagar Rao, Speaker of the Legislative Assembly Haribhau Bagade, University Vice Chancellor Suhas Pednekar, National President of Sahakar Bharati Jyotindra Mehta and National General Secretary of Sahakar Bharati, Dr Uday Joshi.

Starting off by stating how glad he was to be visiting the Mumbai University, Naidu went on to speak at length about co-operatives. "Sharing and caring are the core of Indian philosophy. India's

over 25 crores. The corporates' command the cotton, fertilisers, sugar and processing industries in the country. The iconic success of Amul has inspired a white revolution in India with the country becoming the top milk producer in the world."

Talking about the obstacles the co-operatives face, the Vice President continued, "In recent years, however, the co-operative sector has faced structural challenges like dormant membership, lack of active participation of members in the management, politicisation and bureaucratic control. Similarly, low level of participation by women and youth is a challenge and needs to be addressed. India is a country with 130 crore population and is growing, but we are not focusing enough on controlling population. We have to increase food production. For a country our size, you can't depend on imported food security."

"Urbanisation is a reality, you can't reverse it. The government has resolved to double the farmer's income by 2022, for which a number of interventions are necessary. We have to focus on agriculture and rural development. You can't have temporary solutions for agriculture problems. The co-operatives can help in reducing the cost of production by sensitising farmers about the judicious use of chemical fertilisers and pesticides, by encouraging and training them in the use of organic manure and efficient use of water."

The vice-president stressed five things one should always strive to remember. "You should never forget your mother, or your native place. Nowadays, people want to study in universities abroad, which is okay, you should learn, but come back to India! Always remember your native language, your motherland and your guru," he concluded.

## Separating plastic for a cleaner future

**I**n a new initiative, the Kalyan Dombivli Municipal Corporation along with the Jagrut Nagrik Manch, has been separating plastic from other waste at the Aadharwadi dumping ground in Kalyan. In a space of one acre, the project involves treating of non-plastic waste and sending it for recycling.

For the project, 12 garbage pickers and one JCB have been pressed into service to glean out the plastic from the mountain of trash in the dumping ground.

About 40 gunny bags of



plastic are separated out every day. The remaining garbage is treated for decomposition. Spraying will be carried out every four days, and the result is expected to be seen in about a month.

KDMC Commissioner Govind Bodke, local MLA Narendra Pawar and JNM head Srinivas Ghanekar, have been monitoring the project and have visited the site recently.

## Police resource center unveiled in Bhayandar

**T**o further promote the concept of technology-driven policing, mainly in cases related to online crimes, child labour and sex trafficking, the Bhayandar division of the Thane (rural) police in association with the International Justice Mission (IJM), has established the Police Resource Center for Investigation of Online Crimes.

A brainchild of Assistant SP, Atul Kulkarni, the center which is located within the premises of the Bhayandar police station was inaugurated by Special Inspector General (Konkan Range), Nawal Bajaj, in the presence of Thane (rural) SP, Dr Shivaji Rathod, on Thursday.

Apart from a library of case studies and availability of experts for rendering technical support towards analysis of online trafficking crimes, the



center will be staffed so as to provide mentoring in terms of methods of investigation, research, documentation and specially designed software allowing centralisation of data.

"This resource centre will serve as a space where data related to trafficking will be documented for analytical and reporting purpose," said Bajaj.

"To cope with the challenging questions confronting today's policing, data management and knowledge-based analysis of both, the crime as well as the criminals, has become extremely crucial," said Mellisa

Walwalkar, Director of Justice Solutions, in IJM, the largest anti-trafficking organisation which has armed the center with resources and needed expertise.

"Criminal elements are more covert due to advanced technology and the combat demands updated facilities and enhanced skills of police personell," said Kulkarni.

In order to create a resource hub aimed at enabling co-ordinated investigations and data management all the Anti-Human Trafficking Units (AHTU) falling under the jurisdiction of the Konkan range will be integrated.
